

# Self-Serve Watercraft Cleaning Station at Schroeder Park on Cedar Lake Installed First of a Kind in Wright County

Schroeder Park on Cedar Lake-Wright County has a great new watercraft cleaning station for boaters to use to reduce the chance of spreading aquatic invasive species.

## What does the cleaning station do?

A watercraft cleaning station (called CD3 for clean, drain, dry, dispose) is available by the Schroeder Park access (north side of Cedar). The cleaning station is:

- ✓ **FREE to use**
- ✓ Designed to be self-serve and easy to use
- ✓ Lighted
- ✓ Cleaning tools include:
  - ◇ Wet/dry vacuum
  - ◇ Air blowers
  - ◇ Brush
  - ◇ Grabber
  - ◇ Wrench



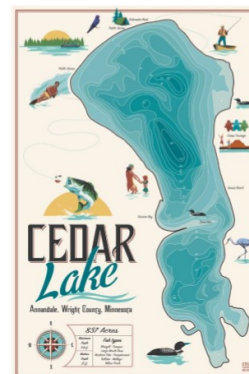
